



Purpose:

This SOG outlines incident responses when 1 or more apparatus is currently assigned to separate incidents.

Scope:

This SOG will apply to all personnel of the Pacific Fire Protection District.

Guidelines:

If the station is unmanned and an additional call is received that would normally be a tone for on-duty-staff and the dispatcher suspects the on-duty unit will be available within a short time period (less than 5 minutes) the dispatcher has the option of toning an on-duty station alarm. The on-duty personnel will advise if they can handle the call or a General Alarm is required. The Company Officer shall have the discretion in responding to any/or all calls for service.

EMS Calls:

Engineer shall respond to all EMS calls which are considered “life threats”. Prior to leaving, the Engineer will grab the EMS bag and AED from a large apparatus and notify dispatch of their response with vehicle identification. Responding Engineer shall have the discretion to disregard any additional Fire units previously assigned to the alarm.

MVA Calls:

Calls on Interstate 44 – Engineer shall remain at the station unless directed otherwise from Duty Officer.

MVA’s with Rescue (non-Interstate) – Engineer shall give no less than 5 minutes to go responding from time of dispatch to allow time for additional personnel to respond to the engine house. Engineer shall don appropriate PPE prior to responding.

All other MVA’s -- Engineer shall remain at the station unless directed otherwise from Duty Officer.

Structure Fire Calls:

Engineer shall give no less than 5 minutes to go responding from time of dispatch to allow time for additional personnel to respond to the engine house. Engineer shall don appropriate PPE prior to responding.

Alarm Sounding Calls:

Engineer shall give no less than 5 minutes to go responding from time of dispatch to allow time for additional personnel to respond to the engine house. Engineer shall don appropriate PPE prior to responding.

Brush Fire Calls:

Engineer shall remain at the station unless directed otherwise from Duty Officer.
